We're so excited to see you at our Spring Seminar! We've gotten great feedback already for people planning to attend, but the more the merrier! I promise you won't want to miss this!

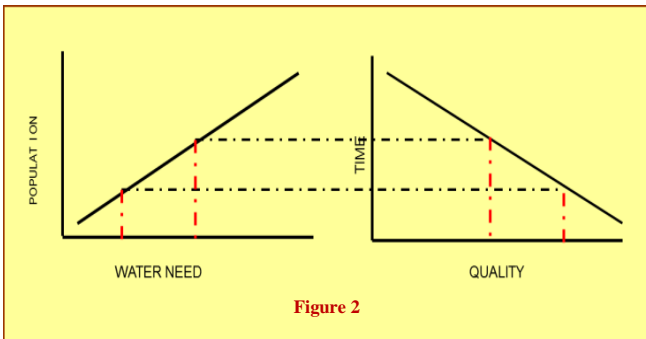

Approximately 40 percent of the entire population of the planet has little or no access to safe clean water. Every **8 seconds**, somewhere in the world a child dies from drinking dirty water.

Total global water use **has quadrupled** over the past 100 years, and it is now increasing faster than it ever has been before. Today, there are **1.6 billion**

people that live in areas of the globe that are considered to be "water-stressed", and it is being projected that two-thirds of the entire population of the globe will be experiencing "water-stressed" conditions by the year 2025. According to USAID, **one-third of the people on earth** will be facing "severe" or "chronic" water shortages by the year 2025.

What do these facts reveal? Water is no longer accessible everywhere and using traditional methods for water treatments are no longer acceptable in this critical day and century.
